COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Chief Sgro reported that the Police Department responded to 187 calls for service in April.

A random safety checkpoint, in participation with the Division of Motor Vehicles resulted in 60 summonses issued for safety and other violations, and many vehicles were given inspections on the spot.

On April 30th the department participated in Operation Take Back. Our residents turned in over 70 pounds of unwanted medications.

The police department has been continuing their efforts to deal with quality of life issues. In addition to the normal duties as traffic enforcement and routine patrol, the police have been focusing on property maintenance as well as issues with trash and other debris placed at curbside at inappropriate times. Chief Sgro asks that everyone pay attention to the new recycling calendar and please remember that no trash or recycling items may be stored in front yards or put to the curb prior to the day before a scheduled pickup.
