#### INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCE:

##### ORDINANCE 15-01-725

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PINE BEACH IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, ESTABLISHING MINIMUM-MAXIMUM LIMITATIONS ON SALARIES TO BE PAID THE MAYOR, COUNCILPERSONS AND ALL OTHER MUNICIPAL OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH" AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES

This ordinance will be advertised in the Asbury Park Press on January 21, 2015 and will have a public hearing at 7:30 pm on February 11, 2015.
