

BOROUGH OF PINE BEACH
SPECIAL MEETING
June 22, 2015

2015 Budget

Warren Korecky, Suplee, Clooney & Company, stated that the Borough's 2015 budget is approved for adoption, is in compliance with the spending cap and the tax levy cap. Mr. Budesca asked what our increase was. Mrs. Steib stated roughly three and half cents seven cents overall. Mr. Abatemarco asked what does that mean to the average homeowner. Mrs. Steib stated it would be approximately \$185.00 per year on a home assessed at \$250,000.
