Pine Beach Native Helps Film Cuba Documentary

Life holds many turns, surprises and opportunities, especially when following and working hard toward one's goals, as Pine Beach resident and Pace University student Joseph Gonzalez found when he and a cadre of fellow students and professors traveled to Cuba earlier this spring.

The mission behind the trip was to film a short documentary on the improving relations between the United States and Cuba, including President Barack Obama's diplomacy visit (the first of any sitting president since the country became subject of an over 50-year embargo shortly after its Communist dictatorial revolution in 1959), a look at the potentials behind its slowly thawing tourist economy, the benefit of introducing widespread internet access, and topped off with a concert by the Rolling Stones,



among other things.

Summer Arts & Crafts Program

All Pine Beach Elementary school students are invited to attend a 5-week Artistic Talent Program that meets twice a week at the Pine Beach Municipal Building. Children will meet for an age-appropriate class to do arts & crafts, and gain knowledge of substance abuse. Please note that the grades listed are for the grade the child has just finished, not the one they are going to be attending in September.

**Dates: Tuesdays and Thursdays
July 12th through August 11th**

Grades K - 2

July 12th, 14th, August 2nd, August 4th: 9:00 AM – 10:00 AM
(For kindergartners it will be 9-10 AM all 5 weeks)

The first hour will be the arts & crafts class and the second hour the kids will participate in a class called Footprints for Life. Footprints for Life is a research-based primary prevention program designed to build assets and teach skills through the use of puppets and stories that feature "real-life" situations. This program is designed to promote development of necessary assets to deter the first use of alcohol and other drugs and is focused on five key social competencies: Planning and decision making skills, interpersonal skills, cultural competence, peer pressure and peaceful conflict resolution.

The first hour will be the arts & crafts class and the second hour the kids will participate in a class called "Unique You". Unique You is an evidence-based substance abuse prevention program that helps children realize their specialness. Positive self-esteem is critical to the development of a healthy individual. The importance of a child's self-esteem is reflected in Unique You through the process of questions, exercises, and session goals.



The Pine Beach Vol. Fire Company, along with the Pine Beach Yacht Club, will host our borough's first-ever annual fire festival this September, featuring food trucks, crafters, music, activities - including games and rides - for children, plus fire safety and rescue demonstrations.

The Pine Beach Vol. Fire Company is an all-volunteer organization that has served Pine Beach and surrounding communities since 1925. Currently, they have 35 members who handle between 150 and 250 emergency calls each year. Over 300 alarms were responded to in 2012, including many due to the aftermath of Hurricane Sandy. In addition to serving Pine Beach, the fire company covers Beachwood from 6 am to 6 pm plus respond anywhere in Ocean County when mutual aid is requested.

The Pine Beach Yacht Club this year celebrates its 100th year offering sailing and social functions to families of Pine Beach and the neighboring communities, including helping our area's needy by collecting food during the annual Feed the Need Regatta for St. Vincent de Paul food pantry at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Beachwood. Some of the season's social highlights include the Champagne Brunch, Annual Bike Hike, Commodore's Open House and more. PBYC's Junior Sailing Program has been going strong since its inception in 1975, with our dedicated staff of instructors taking many young sailors under their guidance, some of whom have brought recognition to the club in the form of bay or river championships. Additionally, the club's junior membership provides a great opportunity for children to meet, learn and grow in an environment focused on excellence in racing, sportsmanship, and water safety.

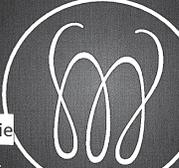
